SOLA AIRPORT IN STAVANGER, NORWAY

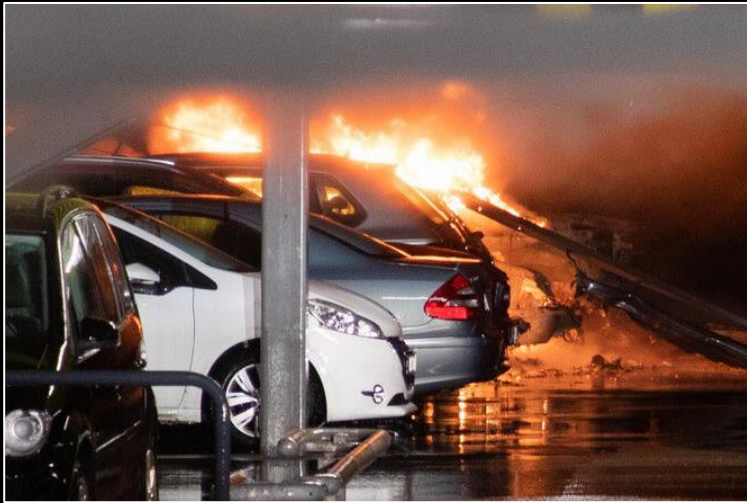

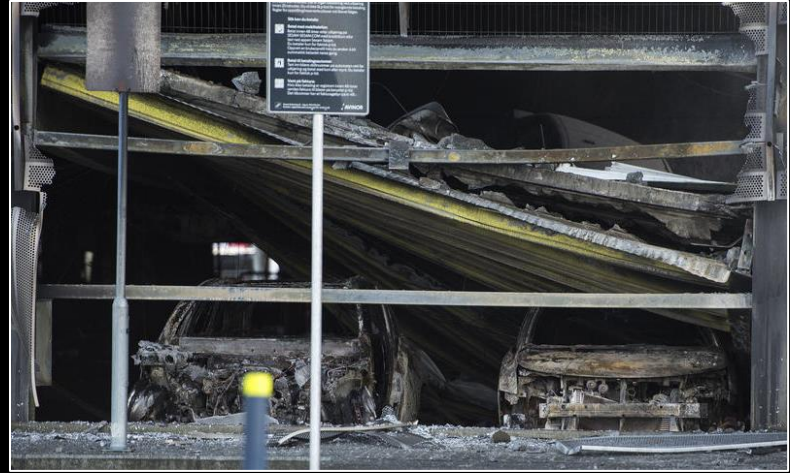
The carpark holds up to 3,000 vehicles and was at near full capacity when the fire broke out. Fire Services were trying to extinguish the fire for over 6 hours using 60+ firefighters. Over 300 vehicles were destroyed.

Furthermore, the fire produced such thick smoke and fumes it caused flights to be grounded, the airport to evacuate 1700 people, and some nearby hotels had to be evacuated. The link below captured the amount of smoke and fumes produced by the cars burning in the fire.
