



Fire Breaks out at Jaguar car dealership as nine engines and drones battle blaze 7th April 2023

The incident happened overnight at the Inchcape Jaguar Land Rover dealership on Bluebell way engulfed in flames as a huge pillar of smoke rises into the sky while, which caused extensive damage to a section of the building.

A **Bridgehill Car Fire Blanket** placed over vehicles with electrical problems creates a quarantine area that contains smoke, fumes, heat and limits the spread of fire to adjacent vehicles or the building itself.



Lancashire Fire and Rescue Service warned firefighters will remain at the scene for several hours battling the flames.

Lancashire Fire and Rescue Service said in a statement: “At 01:03 on 07th April, nine fire engines from Fulwood, Preston, Penwortham, Bamber Bridge, Longridge, Darwen, Blackburn, Hyndburn, and Chorley, together with 2 aerial ladder platforms from Preston and Hyndburn, attended a commercial building fire on Bluebell Way, Preston. The incident involved a commercial property approximately 100 x 100m in size.”

The incident was declared closed at 10:45am on 8th April

Due to the fire Inchcape Jaguar and Land Rover dealership was temporarily closed as an investigation into the incident was launched.
