On July 23rd, 2019, a fire broke out in a warehouse in Washington, UK. As firefighters from Tyne and Wear Fire & Rescue Service tackled the blaze, they realised 2 forklifts were the cause of the fire. The forklifts caught alight by an electrical fault - one was 80% damaged and the other 50%.

From the images below you can see the damaged caused by the smoke, fumes, and fire to not only the forklifts but to the warehouse as well.






